

It's that time of year again to remind stakeholders of an important data contribution opportunity to the LANDFIRE program. LANDFIRE (LF) is an interagency vegetation, fire, and fuel characteristics mapping program sponsored by the United States Department of Agriculture Forest Service (USFS) and the Department of the Interior (DOI) (<u>https://landfire.gov</u>). To ensure LF products are current to support landscape assessment, analysis, and management decisions, LF relies heavily on data contributions from federal, state, local, private, and non-profit land managers.

Data Submission Deadline

LF has transitioned to annual updates and needs as much time as possible to process data. LF is asking for data to be submitted or available in database systems by October 31st.

The focus of this data call is to collect fiscal year 2023 disturbance and treatment activities (10/1/2022 – 9/30/2023). **Please make every effort to have your FY 2023 data accessible to LF by October 31, 2023.** Data accessibility may include entering data into online databases/Systems of Record (SOR) so it can be obtained by LF. Disturbance/Treatment Date or Fiscal Year Required

LF has transitioned to processing data by fiscal year and now requires **disturbance/treatment date or fiscal year** to be included with all data submissions. Month, day, and year for the start and end dates of the disturbance or treatment are preferred.

LANDFIRE Data Needs:

• Primary focus - Polygon Disturbance and Treatment Activities that occurred in FY 2023

LF uses recent disturbance and treatment data to help attribute a disturbance cause to image-based change detections and update map layers in areas where vegetation and fuel have changed. Examples of these types of data are listed in Table 1. Requested attributes (required, recommended, and optional) are listed in Table 2. • Secondary focus – Vegetation/Fuel Plot Data
