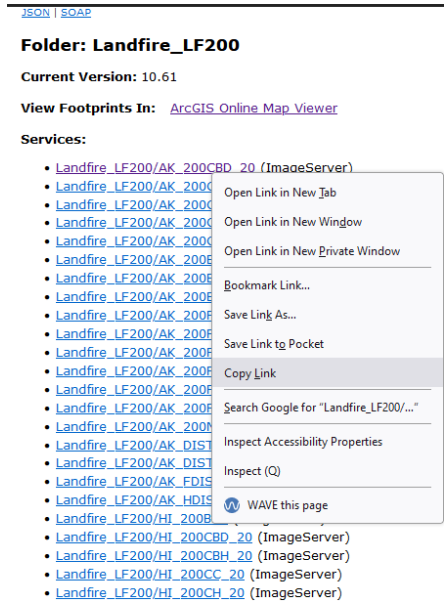
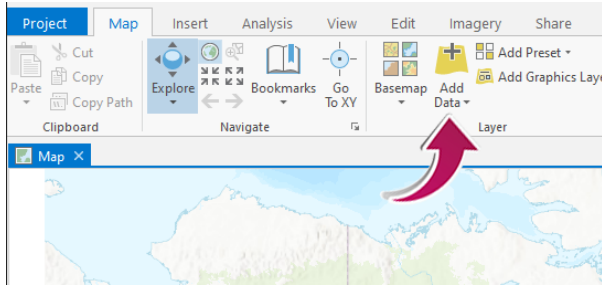
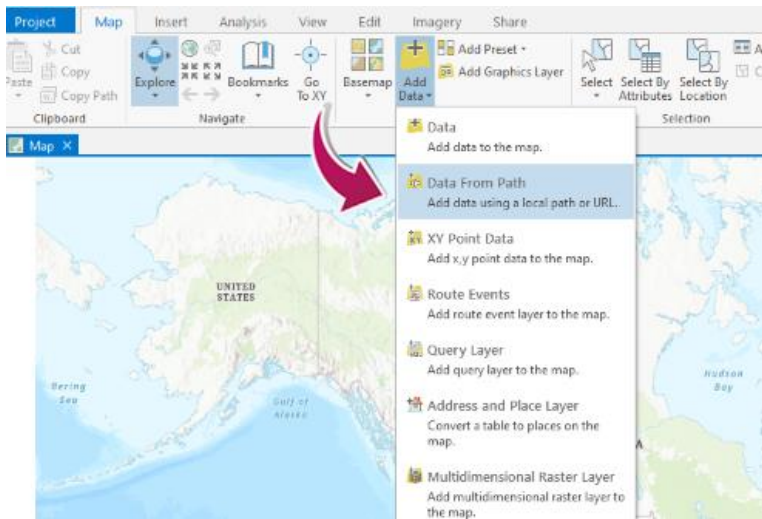


How to use Image Service URLs in ArcPro

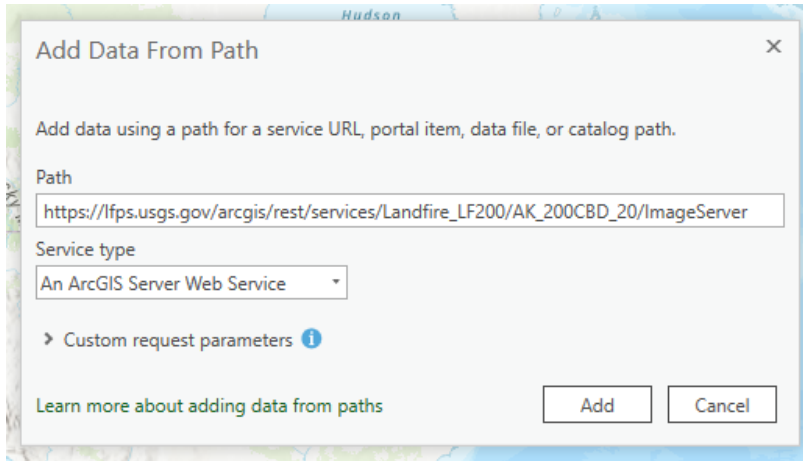
1. Select a LF 200 Image Service URL from https://lfps.usgs.gov/arcgis/rest/services/Landfire_LF200
 - a. Right click on any of the URLs to **Copy Link**
2. Start ArcGIS Pro (ArcPro)
3. Start a “Map”
4. Click on **Add Data** (plus sign)



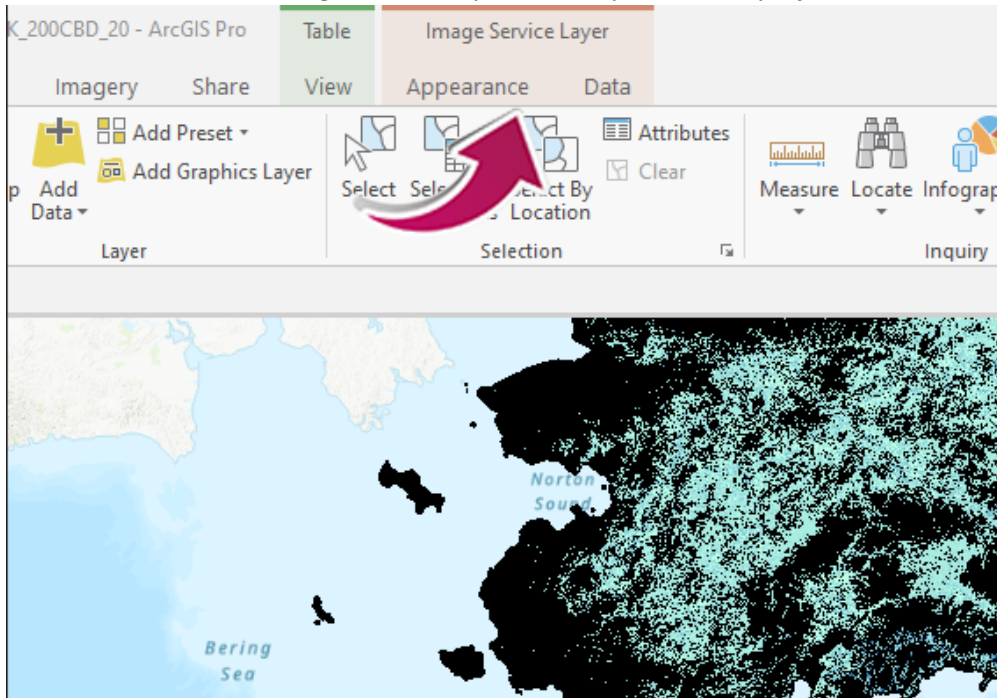
5. Select **Data From Path**



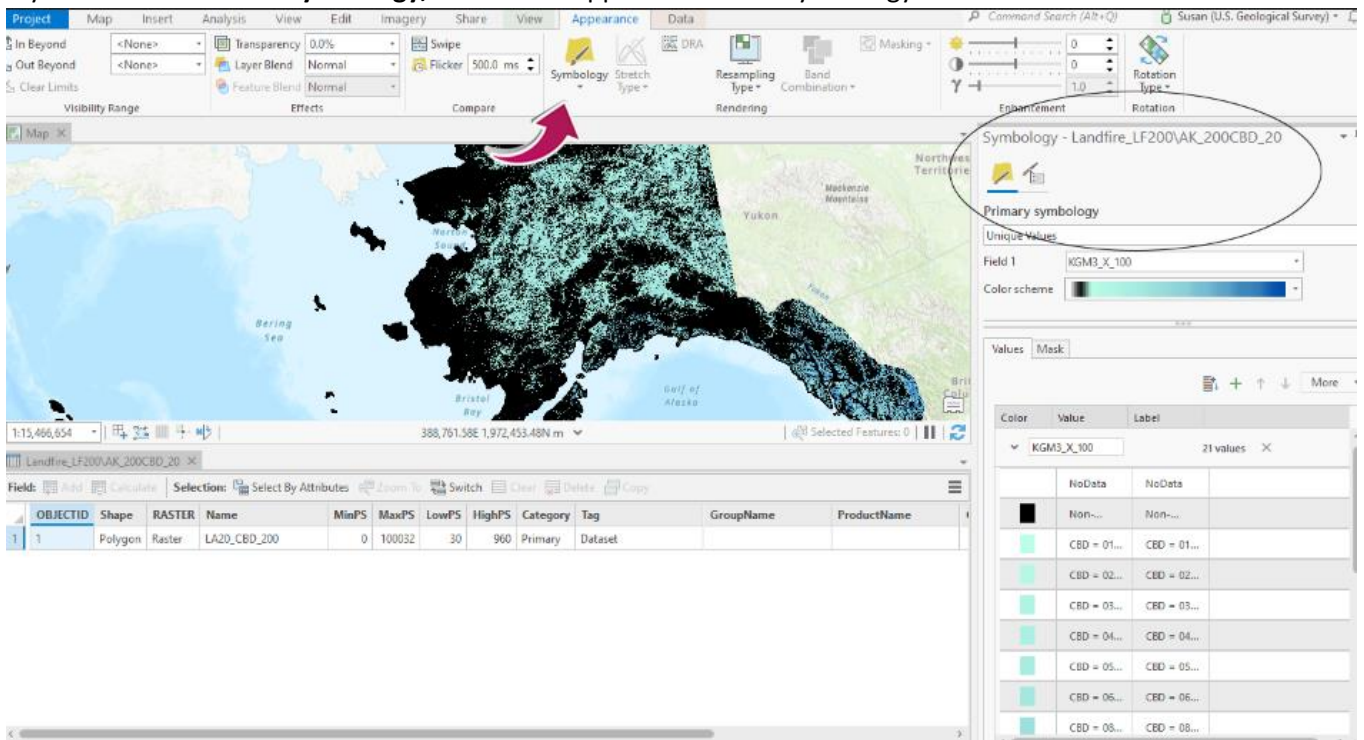
6. Copy the Image Service URL link from Step 1 into the “Path” text box



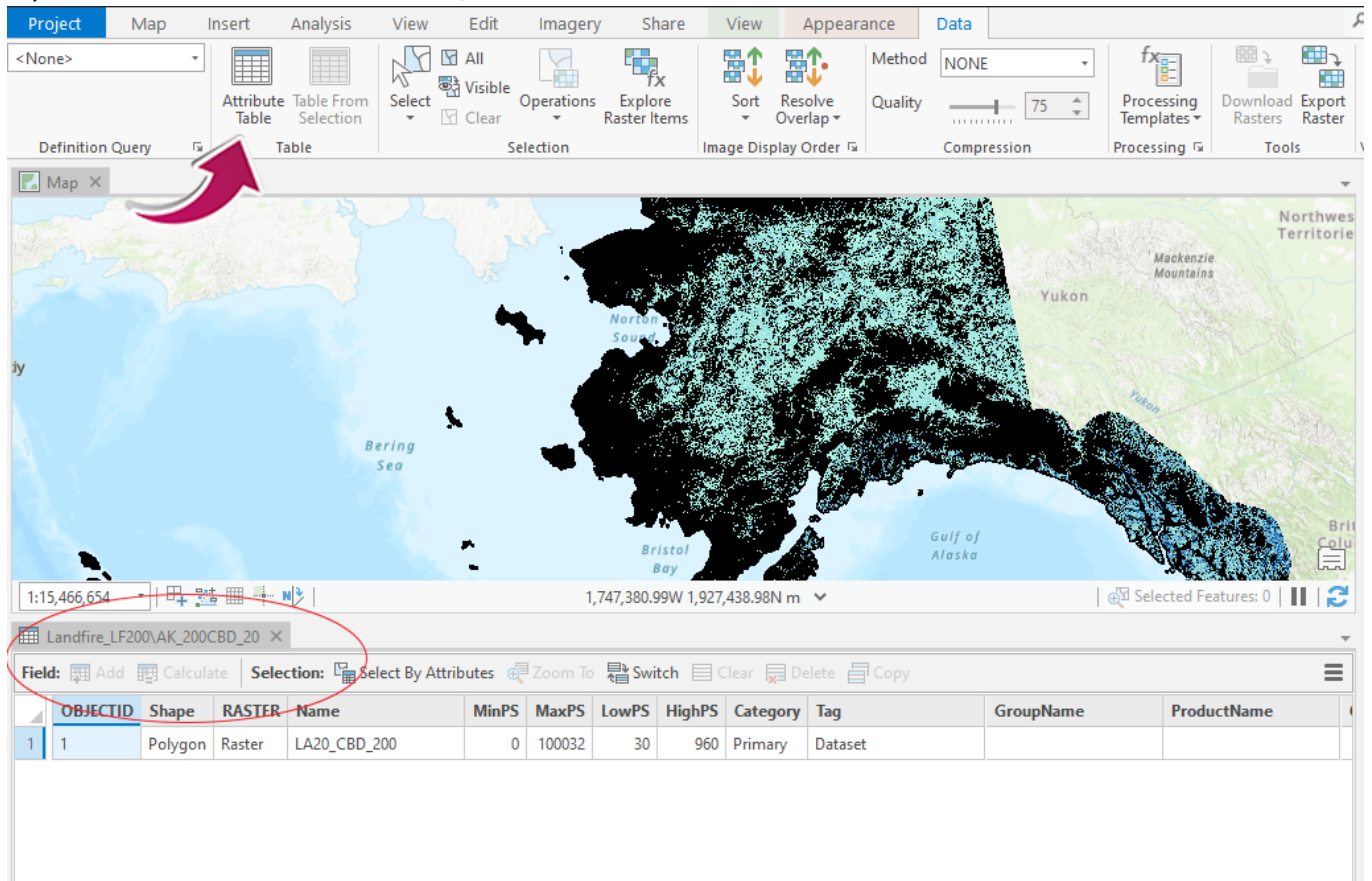
- Click "Add"
- There will now be an "Image Service Layer" tab in your ArcPro project.



- If you want to view the **Symbology**, select the "Appearance" and Symbology icon.



10. If you want to view the attribute table, select the **Data** tab and then select the “Attribute Table” icon



11. To “Identify” unique values per pixel, **click on the map**, and a pop-up screen will appear to show you the identifying information for that pixel.
